TENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME: In the Gospel of Mark, Jesus' early ministry conflicts with those who think they know him. He teaches by telling stories to get his listeners to think beyond what they believe they know. Jesus is then forced to look beyond his biological family for advocates and understanding. It is in living and doing the will of God that now creates family and brings about the kingdom of God in our world as we know it. The Genesis narrative in the first reading today recounts the consequences of humankind's disobedience to God. God presented his agreement through Adam. Adam must take responsibility for his actions. Adam fails, he blames both the woman and God! The woman likewise fails and blames the serpent. As the consequences continue, we learn of the world we inhabit. Relationships with one another and with creation have been disordered by these early choices. We look for God's love and mercy as we continue our journey through life. "With our God, there is mercy and the fulness of redemption".
