STS. PETER AND PAUL APOSTLES



The feast day and remembrance of Saints Peter and Paul only falls on a Sunday every 6 or7 years. Today pause to remember celebrate these two great men in our church. While the readings show us Peter at the high point of

his ministry, they also offer a glimpse of Paul at the end of his career. In this second letter to Timothy the apostle Paul contemplates the end of his life with a sense of peaceful fulfillment. He has faithfully finished the race that God gave him to run. Now he looks forward with hope to his reward: eternal life with God. Just as the angel of the Lord rescued Peter, Paul now praises God for rescuing him from danger. As role models, Peter and Paul both have their weak points. Most of us don't live incircumstances where we are called to be martyred or imprisoned for our faith, but all of us can welcome people into the faith life of our church. As Paul wrote, "To him be glory for ever and ever. Amen!"
