Buried With ORDINARY TIME: Today's Gospel on prayer contains material Baptism for a great deal of reflection. It begins with Luke's version of the Our Father, which is slightly different from the better known prayer; one represents the importance of persistence in prayer; and the other that God hears our prayer.

in prayer; and the other that God hears our prayer. In the Gospel, a disciple requests that Jesus teach them how to pray. Have you ever asked a spiritual mentor to help you to pray? Consider how the readings from Genesis and the Gospel both depict individuals who freely approach God. Abraham reasons with God because he does not think that the decision to kill all the people of Sodom is just, while the other disciple approaches Jesus because he wants to learn from Jesus. It is important for us to remember that God does not merely want to be believed in but to be in relationship with us. God wants to console and uplift the relationship with us. God wants to console and uplift to guide and abellange us. God reveals himself to us, to guide and challenge us. God reveals himself to us and awaits a response. Can you speak freely to God when you are in need?

A MESSAGE FROM POPE LEO XIV "Every relationship that God lives, in himself and for us, thus becomes a gift: when his only Son becomes our brother, his Father becomes our Father, and the Holy Spirit, which joins the Father and the son, comes to dwell in our hearts.
