EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME Luke's Gospel passage for today is a reminder that human beings can be very petty. The man who came to Jesus through the crowd is upset because of a legal dispute with his brother. Jesus telling the man a parable that

telling the man a parable that demonstrates how ridiculous it is to hoard what one has received. The rich man failed to share his abundance with others. Instead, he looked after only himself, thereby revealing that he was poor in what matters to God. God is rich in love, for God is love itself. The more that God's love fills us, the more we will want to share what we have with others will want to share what we have with others. Today's gospel offers us the opportunity to reflect on how we can express gratifude to God for the blessings we have received and share those blessings with others.
