QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Theme: Jesus gives us special gifts.

Family Question: Jesus prayed for his disciples, that others might believe in him through their words. How are you spreading your belief in Jesus through your words and actions? Do others know who Jesus is by knowing you?

First Reading: Acts 7:55-60

Second Reading: Revelation 22:12-14, 16-17, 20

Gospel: John 17:20-26

SEVENTH SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD:

On this seventh Sunday of the Easter Season, we find ourselves between two special celebrations, the Ascension of Jesus and Pentecost, the coming of the Holy Spirit. Today's first reading from Acts recounts the martyrdom of Stephen and introduces Saul, later to be named Paul. Paul will become a key figure in the latter portion of this book. In today's selection, it would be difficult to miss echoes of words heard previously, words that had been spoken by Jesus. Stephen, like Jesus, prays that his executioners may be forgiven. In the Gospel from John we hear, "lifting up his eyes to heaven, Jesus, prayed." The Gospel continues with Jesus' Prayer to his Father. Immediately after this prayer, John's Gospel tells us of Jesus' betrayal and arrest. As you reflect on these readings today, consider how followers of Jesus are invited to live as Jesus lives. More specifically, consider the importance of prayer and forgiveness in the Christian life.
